Policy on Covid19

Belle Academy of Cosmetology follows the current CDC guidelines and The State of Ct Department of Health's Covid19 guidelines. This is an everchanging policy as it is constantly being updated.

Currently everyone entering Belle Academy of Cosmetology must wear a mask while in the building, however, if you are fully vaccinated with a booster, it is your option to wear a mask. A vaccinee card must be provided at enrollment and contract signing, and a copy must remain in the students file.

If a student has chosen not to Vaccinate, it is their choice, they must produce a negative test each and every Tuesday before class starts at sign in. The at home test will be marked with the corresponding date, and copied, a paper copy will be placed in the students file. Test will be given back to the student. If a student has chosen to test at a test center, it must be with in 72 hours attending on Tuesday. The paper results will be placed in the students file each and every week.

If negative, the student may attend classes, if positive, the student must adhere to CDC guidelines and quarantine for at least 5 days. The student must produce a NEGATIVE test to return to school.

If a positive test is produced, the student must notify the school owner asap, do not wait, so Belle Academy of Cosmetology can start Social Tracing as to who was in the building the past 3 days for exposure.
